## Call for Papers

The Accounting Department at Cairo University is pleased to announce its first international conference for accounting. The conference will be held on 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> September 2015 at Marriott Hotel, Cairo, Egypt.

Authors are invited to submit original and unpublished research papers to the CUICA, which could be theoretical and/or empirical using a wide variety of research methodologies and methods including (but not limited to) surveys, case studies, experiments, longitudinal, ethnography, action research, and grounded theory. Papers are welcome in all areas of accounting, which include (but not limited to) the following:

- Adoption of IFRS in developing countries
- Earning management and quality
- Creative accounting
- Financial disclosure and regulations
- Capital markets, mergers and acquisition
- Corporate governance and risk management
- Pension funds and investment strategies
- Performance management and management accounting

This conference represents an excellent opportunity to present your papers, to get engaged with cutting edge research and to share your experience and insights in all areas of accounting. There will be ample opportunities for networking and exchange ideas with conference delegates and keynote speakers.

## Papers submission

Submission can range from early working papers to fully developed papers. Fully developed papers will be presented in the Main Sessions and working papers will be presented in Research Forum Sessions or Posters. Papers/Abstracts should be received by **30 June 2015**

Papers will be subject to a double blind review. Authors will be notified of the decision on their submission by **15<sup>th</sup> July 2015**. For accepted papers, the corresponding author needs to register for the conference by **31 July 2015** for their paper to be included in the conference programme.

Final papers should be received by **15<sup>th</sup> August**. They will be available on the conference website shortly after the submission deadline.

Authors will be given the opportunity to publish their papers in a special issue of either:

- **Cairo University Accounting Journal**
- **Journal of Accounting in Emerging Economies** (to be confirmed)

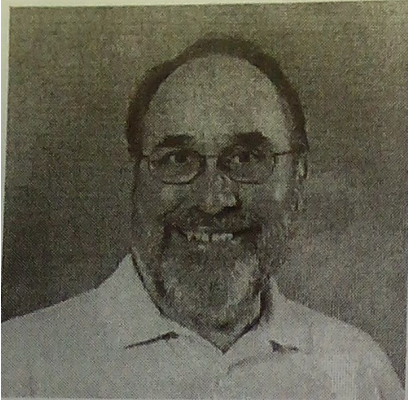
The fees cover conference registration and pack, lunch and tea and coffee for the two days.

## Keynote Speakers

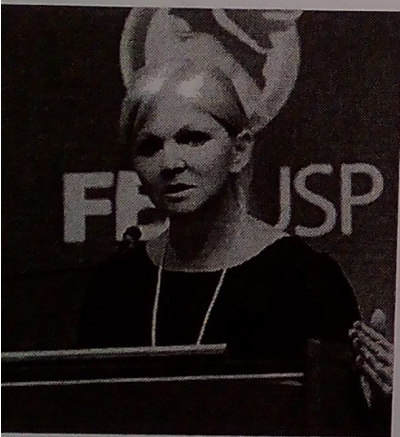


**Professor Mike Shields**  
**Michigan State University, Michigan, USA**

Mike Shields is the Schaberg Endowed Chair in Accounting at Michigan State University. He has published over 60 articles in *Journal of Accounting Research*, *The Accounting Review*, *Accounting, Organizations and Society*, *Contemporary Accounting Research*, *Accounting Horizons*, and *Journal of Management Accounting Research*.

Mike is an editor of *Accounting, Organizations and Society* and was the editor of the *Journal of Management Accounting Research*. He was President of the Management Accounting Section of the American Accounting Association. He is a director of the IMA Foundation of the Institute of Management Accountants and a member of the Research Board of the Chartered Institute of Management Accountants.

In 2006 Mike received the Lee Brummet Distinguished Service Award for Educators from the Institute for Management Accountants. He also received the American Accounting Association's Notable Contributions to Management Accounting Literature Award in 2008 and 2013 and to Behavioral Accounting Literature In 2008.



**Professor Christine Cooper**  
**University of Strathclyde, Glasgow, UK**

Christine is Professor in Accounting at the University of Strathclyde. Her research is broadly concerned with the impact of accounting in our everyday lives. This broad interdisciplinary arena has two dominant strands. The first is concerned with the probably unanswerable question - why do we do what we do. The second strand is concerned with the wider economic and social impact of accounting on people's lives. She published articles in *Accounting, Organizations and Society*, *Critical Perspectives on Accounting*, *Accounting, Auditing and Accountability Journal*, *Accounting Forum*, *Human Relations*, *Production Planning and Control*, and *British Journal of Management*.

Christine is a Co-editor of *Critical Perspectives on Accounting*, Joint Editor of the *Journal of the Association for Accountancy and Business Affairs*, Associate Editor of *Accounting and the Public Interest*, and on the Editorial Board of *Accounting, Auditing and Accountability Journal* and *Accounting Forum*.
