Green was a sacred color to the Egyptians, representing the hope and joy of spring. It is also a sacred color to Moslems. Many mosques and religious temples throughout the world use green (the color of renewal and growth) and blue (the color of heaven) to balance heavenly peace with spiritual growth. To sum up, color influences us in many ways (Daniels 10).'

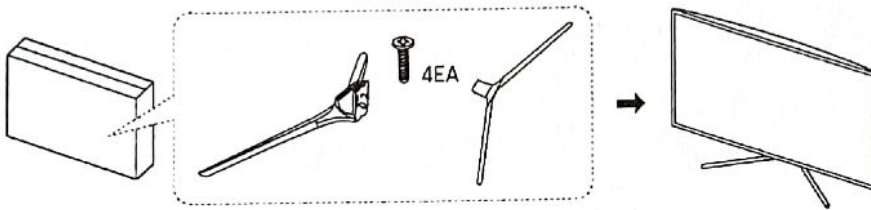

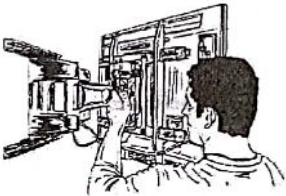
Assembling the TV

Mounting the TV on a wall

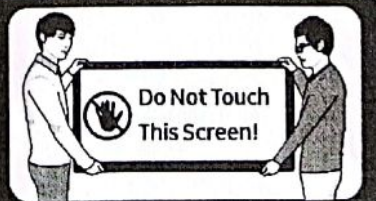

Answer the following questions:

I- *Things Fall Apart* emerged in opposition to a long history of European misrepresentations of Africa. The novel answered a need for African stories told from an African perspective. In response to Joyce Cary's *Mister Johnson* and other landmark modernist novels of Africa such as Joseph Conrad's *Heart of Darkness*, Achebe depicted an African reality with compassion and complexity. Until the publication of *Things Fall Apart* in 1958, very few English-language texts written by Africans had been published. Achebe's novel was a game changer. Discuss with reference to Achebe's use of English and support your answer with evidence from the text. (16 Marks)

II- Comment critically on the following quotation:

(16 Marks)

Turning and turning in the widening gyre

The falcon cannot hear the falconer;

Things fall apart; the centre cannot hold;

Mere anarchy is loosed upon the world. W.B. Yeats "The Second Coming"

While the first section of the novel shows and depicts the identity of the community in Umuofia which adheres to its customs and traditions and is very sticking to this identity, the second section depicts an attempt to destabilize this identity and to impose another identity on it. The title of the novel reflects these things that began to be shaken by colonialism. This title, which the writer quoted from William Butler Yeats's poem, could be a reflection of the influence of colonialism on peoples. When the colonizers enter, there will be no centre or reference. Instead, chaos and loss of identity will prevail, and then the tragedy truly begins. In your point of view, has the Igbo culture and community fallen apart after the arrival the colonizer?
