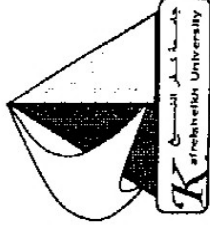

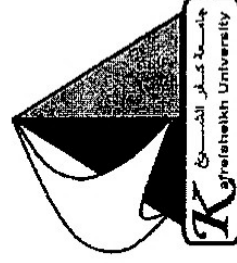

Fluttering and dancing in the breeze.

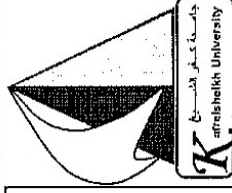
Continuous as the stars that shine
