4- Cirrhotic patient presented to OPD with abdominal pain and fever over the last one week. OE had abdominal distension with ascites and



tender right iliac fossa. Diagnostic aspirate of ascetic fluid showed this color, give one possible cause.



5- This cirrhotic patient with ascites presented to the ER by abdominal pain and on examination stepladder, dilated loops were seen, which bowel loops are seen distended?



6- Which of the followings is the least likely an indication for liver biopsy:

- 1- Assess unexplained abnormal liver biochemistry
- 2- Diagnosis of the type of cirrhosis
- 3- Evaluation of undetermined liver masses and cysts
