Course Description

Course Title: Anatomy I

Course Code: (Med 120101)

Credit Hours: Theory (2hrs) +Lab (1)

Pre-requisite: None

Co-requisite: Med 120102

This course provides students the opportunity to examine the anatomy of the body as a whole: cavities, boundaries & content: different types of body tissues; musculoskeletal system different types of bones. Joints: muscles of trunk, abdomen, cardiac, and smooth). The relationship between structure and function are emphasized. The course progresses from the structure of cells and tissues to the anatomy of the integrated organ systems of the body. Emphasis on clinical application of basic anatomical knowledge to be employed in their practice of nursing.

Course Title: Anatomy II

Course Code: (Med 120104)

Credit Hours: Theory (2hrs)

Pre-requisite: Med 120101

Co-requisite: Med 120105

This course is a continuation of 120101 course; it provides the students the opportunity to examine the anatomy of the systems of the humans body; Nervous, cardiovascular, digestive, respiratory, Urinary tract, endocrine and eye. The relationship between structure and function are emphasized. Emphasis on clinical application of basic anatomical knowledge to be employed in their practice of nursing.

Course Title: Physiology I

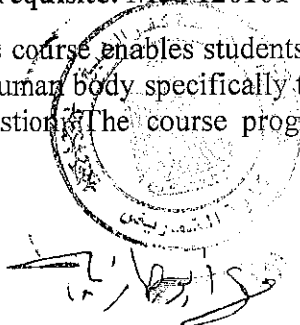
Course Code: (Med 120102)

Credit Hours: Theory (2hrs)

Pre-requisite: None

Co-requisite: Med 120101

This course enables students to understand the fundamental facts and concepts of the normal function of human body specifically the systems responsible for support, movement, circulation respiration and digestion. The course progresses from the function of cells and tissues to the physiology of the





integrated organ systems of the body. It deals with basic regulatory mechanisms which promote homeostasis; Familiarization with some physiological parameters which serve as indicators for the organism's state of health.

Course Title: Physiology II

Course Code: (Med 120105)

Credit Hours: Theory (2hrs)

Pre-requisite: Med 120102

Co-requisite: Med 120104

This course is continuation for physiology I. This course will help students to understand the fundamental concepts of the normal function of the human body. The course progresses from the function of cells and tissues to the physiology of the integrated organ systems of the body. It deals with basic regulatory mechanisms which promote homeostasis.

Course Title: Biochemistry

Course Code: (Med 120103)

Credit Hours: 3hrs (Theory)

Pre-requisite: None

Co-requisite: None

This course will enable nursing students to demonstrate understanding of the essential topics of biochemistry including micro and macromolecules of carbohydrates, lipids, proteins, nucleotides and nucleic acids.

Course Title: Sociology (علم اجتماع)

Course Code: Sup 120101

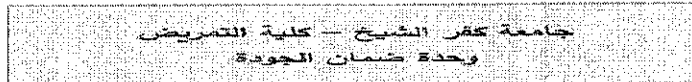
Credit Hours: 2hrs (Theory)

Pre-requisite: None

Co-requisite: None

Course Title: Pathophysiology

Course Code:(Med 120101)

Credit Hours: Theory (3hrs)

Pre-requisite: MED 120102 , MED 120105

Co-requisite: None

This course provides student an opportunity to examine health deviations and their impact on human functioning. It is designed to facilitate student's development of nursing system, thereby enabling the student to manage the health deviations of the individual therapeutically. This course introduces mechanisms of disease and illness that affect health individuals throughout the life span. Alterations in psychological processes are examined with an emphasis on client health.

Course Title: Pharmacology

Course Code: MED 120102

Credit Hours: Theory (2hrs)

Pre-requisite: Med 120105

Co-requisite: None

This course will introduce nursing students to the science of pharmacology with emphasis on the biotransformation, absorption, actions, interactions, adverse effects of each drug classification. There will be an emphasis on assessing and evaluating patient responses that change in accordance with health, age, lifestyle, gender, and other factors.

Course Title: Applied Pharmacology

Course Code:(Med 120103)

Credit Hours: Theory (2hrs)

Pre-requisite: MED 120102

Co-requisite: None

This course is designed to assist nursing students to apply the principles and basic standards of drugs administration for clients with health deviations with emphasis on the actions, interactions, adverse effects, and nursing implications of each drug classification. Emphasis on assessing and evaluating patient responses that changes in accordance with health, age, lifestyle, gender, and other factors.



Course Title: Applied Nutrition

Course Code: MED 120301

Credit Hours: Theory (2hrs)

Pre-requisite: Med 120103

Co-requisite: None

This course introduces student to the fundamental concepts of nutritional therapy and emphasizes application of interventions in patient care, Health promotion through nutrition intervention is examined.

Course Title: Fundamentals of Nursing

Course Code:(NUR 120101)

Credit Hours: Theory (3hrs) + 3 Lab

Pre-requisite: None

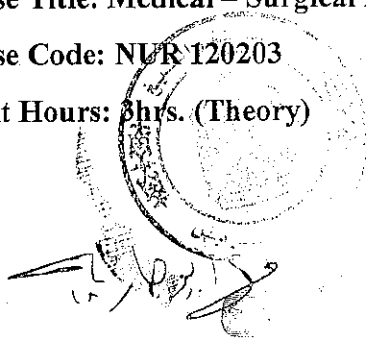
Co-requisite: Med 120101 + Med 120102

This course is designed to introduce students to the major concepts and theories related to the paradigm of person. Health, environment and the discipline of nursing. It introduces students to nursing as a dynamic and caring profession. Emphasis is placed on wellness, physiological, social, culture and spiritual factors which contribute to the well-being of the individual and family. The concepts of nursing process and clinical decision making are explored. Communication is emphasized as an essential aspect of the professional role and is applied through interviews and data collections. Also, emphasis is placed on the professional role of the nurse and being aware of patient's rights and the issues of privacy. Related theories from behavioral and physical sciences are incorporated. The course also is provided to provide students with practical foundation of nursing practice. Learning experiences introduce students to the role of nurse as in integral member of the health care system. Emphasis is placed on the art and science of nursing including development and refinement of basic nursing skills which provide the foundation for holistic, evidence – based practice. Students begin to develop critical thinking skills through development and application of the nursing process. The clinical experience is designed to provide students the opportunity to develop basic nursing skills and begin to develop a holistic, caring approach with patients and families in different health care setting.

Course Title: Medical – Surgical Nursing (1)

Course Code: NUR 120203

Credit Hours: 3hrs. (Theory)





Pre-requisite: NUR 120101, NUR 120102, Med 120101, Med 120102

Co-requisite: NUR 120204

This course focuses on the holistic nursing care of young, middle, and older adults experiencing an array of bio-psychosocial alteration and the associated response to illness in a variety of health care setting with an emphasis on secondary and tertiary prevention. Emphasis is on professional health care that reflects comprehensive, research and evidence – based humanistic, altruistic, and inter-professional values. The students learn nursing concepts to assist patient in achieving optimal functioning.

This course will assist students with an opportunity to provide care for patients with common uncomplicated medical – surgical health conditions. Emphasis is placed on identification of potential and actual patient problems, and to assist students to incorporate professional standard as a basis for practice, apply critical thinking, set theory and research findings in planning and implementation of care in collaboration with other health team members. Critical thinking, Communication, and clinical competency are key components in this course.

Course Title: Health Assessment

Course Code: NUR 120204

Credit Hours: 2 Theory + 2 Lab (4 hrs.).

Pre-requisite: Med 120101, Med 120104

Co-requisite: NUR 120203

This course is designed to introduce knowledge and skills required to perform a systematic examination across the life span through holistic perspective of client's health status, and to record findings appropriately. Using theoretical and practical approach, student will be provided the opportunity to practice overall physical examination, conducting an overall health assessment.

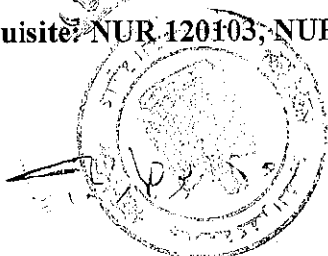
Laboratory clinical experience provide and enable students to apply the theoretical knowledge in order to perform comprehensive physical examination and health assessment for both health and ill clients. Thus, students will develop skills and techniques required for a comprehensive assessment within a legal ethical frame work of nursing profession. Lab time is offered for the development of skills needed to perform physical examination and health assessment on adult clients. Included are interviewing, Subjective and objective data collecting techniques and a review of documentation.

Course Title: Medical – Surgical Nursing (2)

Course Code: NUR 120205

Credit Hours: 3hrs. (Theory) + clinical (4 hrs)

Pre-requisite: NUR 120103, NUR 120104





Co-requisite: None

This course is a continuation of providing holistic nursing care management of young, middle, and older adults experiencing an array of bio-psycho-social responses of adult to actual and high-risk conditions that affect their functional health patterns. These conditions may be acute or long term and the focus will be on selected functional health patterns. The course emphasizes on medical-surgical specialties such as ENT, ophthalmology, orthopedics etc....

Nursing process will be used as a frame work to formulate nursing diagnoses and identify nursing interventions directed towards promoting, maintaining and restoring the health of adults and their families. This course is designed to assist students with opportunity to provide care for adults' patient with medical – surgical health deviations that can potentially lead to a

critical state. The course emphasizes on medical – surgical specialties such ENT, ophthalmology, orthopedics etc....

The clinical experience is designed to provide students an opportunity to incorporate professional standards as a basis for practice, apply critical thinking, and research, best practice – based findings to provide holistic care for adults. Clinical experiences will be in the medical and surgical ward specialties.

Course Title: Bacteriology

Course Code: Med 120206

Credit Hours: 2hrs. Theory

Pre-requisite: None

Co-requisite: None

This course is designed to provide nursing students with an introduction to the biology of micro-organism, particularly the bacteria, fungi, protozoa, and viruses that are agents of human diseases. This includes the biological characteristics of microbes, ant-microbial methods, and concepts of immunity diagnosis and treatment and prevention of infection.

Course Title: Pediatric Nursing

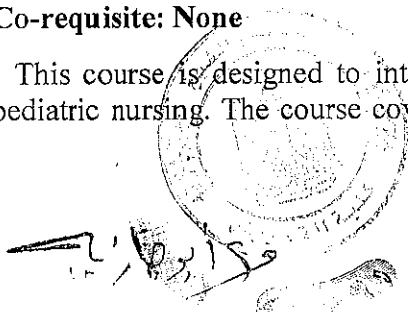
Course Code: NUR 120301

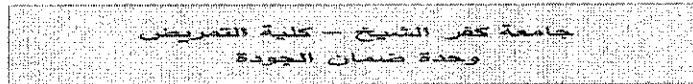
Credit Hours: 3hrs. (Theory) + 4 hrs. clinical

Pre-requisite: NUR 120203, NUR 120204, NUR 120205

Co-requisite: None

This course is designed to introduce nursing students to the basic knowledge, and principles of pediatric nursing. The course covers the health needs of healthy as well as sick child. This course is





designed to introduce nursing students to the basic skills of nursing care provided to children and their families. Clinical experience offered in this course is designed for the purpose of helping students to integrate theory and research- based finding to provide holistic care to children as well as their families.

Course Title: Maternity & Woman Health Nursing

Course Code:(NUR 120304)

Credit Hours: 3hrs. (Theory) + 4 hrs. clinical

Pre-requisite: NUR 120203, NUR 120204, NUR 120205

Co-requisite: None

This course is designed to assist nursing student in developing expertise and in depth understanding in the field of Obstetrics and Gynecological nursing. It helps students to provide

the client with a holistic care. Also this course aiming to providing students with knowledge skills, and attitude to provide safe nursing care based on evidence-based research and best practice finding for women across life span as well as anew born infant in relation to normal and abnormal conditions. It also familiarizes the learner with the concept of high – risk women and facilitates critical thinking skills in providing care for families during childbearing years. The course aims to make the student able to provide nursing care for the female during pregnancy, labor, post-natal, peri-natal and climacteric period in different heath care setting and M.C.H. Clinical experience also includes caring of families during normal pregnancy, high risk pregnancy and during the health newborn period. Concepts of family integrity are used as a basis for the provision of care. In addition, the course provides an excellent opportunity for the student to enhance communication with mothers, their babies and other family members through health education and interaction.

Course Title: Ethical & Legal Aspects of Nursing

Course Code:(NUR 120207)

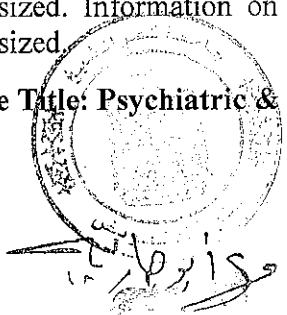
Credit Hours: 2hrs. (Theory)

Pre-requisite: None

Co-requisite: None

This course introduces the legal and ethical issues related to the nursing practice. Laws and ethical principles that guide professional nursing practice in the current health care delivery system is emphasized. Information on ethical principles, malpractice, negligence, and standards of care are emphasized.

Course Title: Psychiatric & Mental Health Nursing





Course Code: NUR 120405

Credit Hours: 3hrs. (Theory) + 4 hrs .

Pre-requisite: NUR 12030, NUR 120304

Co-requisite: None

This course is designed to strengthen the student's concept of health, mental health, human relationships and application of the nursing process with individuals demonstrating maladaptive coping responses. The course also focuses on the nursing assessment and management of individuals with various mental health problems. It presents students to concepts of mental health promotion & illness prevention within individuals, groups, and families in different setting.

The course emphasizes on the understanding of basic mental process within culture, legal & ethical context. Psychiatric and mental health nursing clinical experiences enable student to develop clinical skills in providing care effectively and therapeutically for individuals with an acute or chronic maladaptive coping responses through application of therapeutic nurse-patient relationship, nursing process, holistic intervention. In addition, students are expected to integrate principles of psychiatric nursing, psychopharmacology, and communication skills in providing care for patients and their families. Culture, Legal, and ethical dimensions are maintained all through practice.

Course Title: Community Health Nursing

Course Code: NUR 120401

Credit Hours: 3hrs. (Theory) + 4 hrs. clinical

Pre-requisite: NUR 120301, NUR 120304

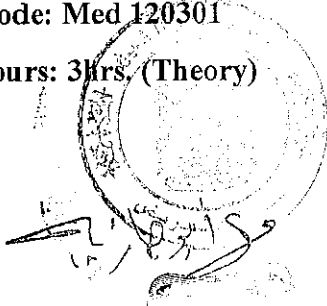
Co-requisite: None

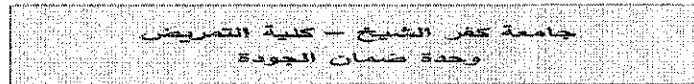
Community health nursing is a field of public health that deals with study of individuals, families, and communities to improve their health considering the three levels of prevention. Using available community resources and evidence based findings as a basis for making judgments in community health nursing plans. This course focuses on the practice of community health nursing. Students assess families and communities to identify health needs and to apply research - based interventions at all levels of prevention of specific needs of identified population groups. Using available community resources. Also, the course will help students to develop advanced communication skills in collaborating with clients and health team members in planning, implementing and evaluating nursing interventions to improve the overall health of the community with the context of primary health care and current models of health promotion.

Course Title: Epidemiology

Course Code: Med 120301

Credit Hours: 3hrs. (Theory)





Pre-requisite: Med 120103

Co-requisite: None

This course provides the opportunity to explore and discuss causes of health and diseases through systematic and rigorous identification of patterns in populations, formulating casual hypothesis. Epidemiology is the basic science of public health and such provides the scientific underpinning for understanding disease pattern so that effective interventions can be proposed, implemented and evaluated.

Course Title: Nursing Informatics

Course Code: NUR 120206

Credit Hours: 2hrs. (Theory)

Pre-requisite: None

Co-requisite: None

Nursing Informatics course is utilizing information systems and technology for improvement and transformation of health care. The focus of this course is on the integration of informatics knowledge, skills, and attitudes to support culturally sensitive, evidence-based practice at leadership level.

Course Title: Critical Care Nursing

Course Code: NUR 120206

Credit Hours: 3hrs. (Theory) + 4 hrs. clinical

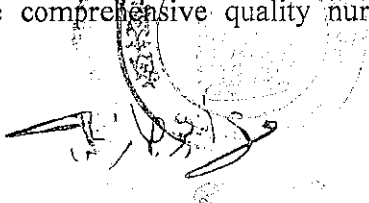
Pre-requisite: NUR 120301, NUR 120304, NUR 120203, NUR 120204 , NUR 120205

Co-requisite: None

This course presents psychological concepts as a basis for understanding disease and nursing assessment findings upon which clinical decisions regarding intervention are made. It provides fundamental information about the nursing process of patients in critical care settings. The course requires synthesis of pathophysiological, pharmacological, and therapeutic concepts.

This course is designed to assist students in developing experience and in – depth knowledge in the field of critical care nursing.

This course is designed to provide students with the skills required to care competently and safely for critically ill patient. It focuses on having the students expand their knowledge – base and master critical care nursing psychomotor skills associated with assessment and provision of comprehensive nursing care for patient with acute life threatening condition and attitudes through reflection in and on action in clinical settings. It also focuses on the application of immediate rapid and accurate nursing assessment and provision of quality nursing care according to priorities. It enable the students to provide comprehensive quality nursing care for critically ill patient with different body system





alterations with different types of invasive devices and with different types of machines encountered in critical care settings and to understand the critical care environment in which practice occurs in order to provide care for the critically ill patients in the different critical care settings. Nursing process is used as an approach of providing holistic patient care. Critical thinking, Clinical judgment, decision making and team work are emphasized in this course.

Course title: Nursing research

Course code: (Nur 120305)

Credit hours: 2 hrs. (theory)

Pre-requisite: none

Co-requisite: none

This course provides students with opportunities to acquire knowledge that promote development of nursing research consumer. The course focuses on the integration of theory, practice, and research. The course will provide students chances to become familiar with the various methods of scientific inquiry including both qualitative and quantitative data. The components of the research process will be presented, explored, and applied. orientation to the research process will provide students the opportunity to understand evidenced – based practice in nursing and health care and to develop basis of critical evaluation of research findings and applying the results to practice in a variety of clinical settings.

Course title: Normal Growth & Development

Course code: (Nur 120302)

Credit hours: 2 hrs.

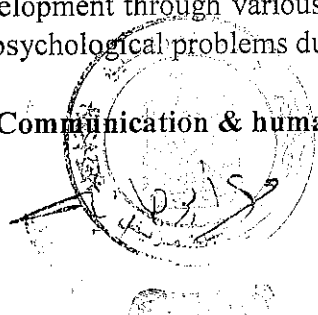
Pre-requisite: none

Co-requisite: none

Growth and development are ongoing process that represents the sum of the changes that take place in the life time of an individual. The entire course is a dynamic process that encompasses several multifaceted and interrelated dimensions; growth development, maturation and differentiation understanding normal growth and development is a mandatory pre – requisite to understand the abnormal events that may occur during disease process. Also , it helps planning interventions to promote healthy well – being at individual , family and community levels .

The course focuses on providing students with the basic concepts and theories of human development throughout lifespan. The course also, emphasizes the role of heredity, environment and community on human development. The course deals with the cognitive, social, and emotional aspects of human development through various developmental theories. It also focuses on the characteristics and common psychological problems during childhood, adulthood and old age.

Course title: Communication & human relations





Course code: (Nur 120208)

Credit hours: 2 hrs.

Pre-requisite: none

Co-requisite: none

Communication skills and human relation course aims at introducing students to theories and models of communication skills which enhance nurse – client interaction, and help students monitor themselves during interaction a therapeutic relationship. This course also strengthen , students , understanding of self , self – motivation , self – awareness and develops creative abilities for goal setting , problems – solving , and critical thinking.

Course title: Emergency nursing

Course code: (Nur 120303)

Credit hours: 3 hrs. (theory) + 4 hrs. clinical

Pre-requisite: Nur 120203, Nur 120204, Nur 120205

Co-requisite: none

This course is designed to provide student with knowledge and skills associated with the delivery of emergency nursing care to an adult patient. The course content is presented through lectures and psychomotor skill stations. Course content reviews pertinent information for the emergency room nurse on the areas of respiratory assessment, shock, first aid, adult triage, resuscitation, trauma nursing.

Practice in emergency settings may range from lifesaving interventions to provide health promotion and injury prevention. This course is designed to assist student to develop psychomotor skills of simulated laboratory / clinical practicum in an emergency setting. It enables the students to provide comprehensive quality nursing care to emergent patient with different body system alteration, with different types of invasive devices and with different types of machines encountered in emergency care setting. Also, it helps student to assess accurately the emergent patient, implement appropriately nursing care of the emergency patient, assist with common emergency procedures, and demonstrate care for the diverse patient condition. Critical thinking, clinical judgment, decision making and team work are emphasized in this course.

Course title: Graduation project

Course code: (Nur 120407)

Credit hours: 2 hrs. (practice)

Pre-requisite: None

Co-requisite: None

Each student will be assigned to design and carryout a project selected from one nursing clinical area for partial fulfillment of graduation.
