

Knowledge (.25marks = 2points)	Recalling basic information about hypertensive emergencies very elevated BP, typically greater than 180/110 mm Hg HTN crisis refers to hypertensive urgencies and emergencies Differentiate between hypertensive emergency and urgency Urgency mean bp higher than 180/110 without target organ damage almost need outpatient care. Case solving (.25 marks = 2points)	Ability to identify the certain disease from case scenario Hypertensive urgency there is no organ damage Choosing the best drug to handle the case Oral captopril is one of the agents of choice The onset of action of oral captopril is 15 to 30 minutes, and a marked fall in BP is unlikely to occur if no hypotensive response is observed within 30 to 60 minutes	•	Identify all the patient's drug therapy problems in all cases Ability to correlate the prescribed drug to the case, give proper opinion about what the patient should do to avoid this case	•	Identify the patient's problem but unable to give proper opinion about it	Fails to identify the problem
